

POINTS ON THE CHEST

R.M.16 ZHONGTING 中庭 CHUNG T'ING

ZHONG 中 The middle, midway, medium, middling. Among, within, in, inside, between. Chinese. To hit the centre, to attain; to be affected by.

TING 庭 A hall; the audience-chamber; the Court; the palace. A courtyard; a court of justice. To grow up straight.

R.M.17 DANZHONG 膺中 TAN CHUNG

DAN 膺 The part between the breasts; the middle of the thorax.

ZHONG 中 The middle, midway, medium, middling. Among, within, in, inside, between. Chinese. To hit the centre, to attain; to be affected by.

R.M.18 YUTANG 玉堂 YÜ T'ANG

YU 玉 A gem, a precious stone, the gem par excellence : jadeite, nephrite. Valuable. Your.

TANG 堂 A hall, a reception room, the ancestral hall; a school, a meeting-place. A court of justice. Venerable, grave. An open level space on the hills. To build. An official title.

R.M.19 ZIGONG 紫宮 TZU KUNG

ZI 紫 Purple, a dark red brown.

Gong cheng 宮城 The impérial city, the forbidden city.

Gong que 宮闕 Gate of the palace.

Gong ting 宮庭 The imperial palace.

R.M.20 HUAGAI 華 蓋 HUA KAI

HUA 華 The blooming of plants, flowers, flowery, variegated; glory, splendour. China, Chinese. Name of a precious stone.

GAI 蓋 To cover, to hide; a cover, an umbrella. To built, to roof, to erect.

R.M.21 XUANJI 璇 璣 HSÜAN CHI

XUAN 璇 A fine kind of jade.

JI 璣 The gear of a rotating, astronomical instrument (armillary sphere)

Xuan ji 璇璣 Ancient astronomical instrument of the time of Shun; perhaps an armillary sphere.

22 BULANG 步廊

BU 步 A pace, consisting of two steps of 2,5 feet each. A step. A land measure of 5 local feet. To follow in the footstep of. On foot.

LANG 廊 A veranda; a corridor; a porch.

23 SHENFENG 神封

SHEN 神 Spirits, gods; divine; supernatural, mysterious. Spiritual (as opp. to material).The soul, the mind. Genius. Inspiration. Force (of expression).

FENG 封 A fief or principality, held under the feudal system. To appoint to territory or office. To bestow honours, to confer nobility; to canonize. A boundary, a dyke. A mound, a tumulus; to heap up. To enrich. To seal up; to attach; a package. To blockade.

24 LINGXU 靈墟

LING 靈 Spiritual, divine, supernatural. Efficacious, ingenious; the spirits of a being which act upon others; having the powers of a medium; response; obedience to; expression. Ingenious, smart, intelligent, ingenious. A coffin with a body (corpse) in.

XU 墟 Waste, wild land; old burial grounds. A fair, a market.

25 SHENZANG 神藏

CANG/ZANG 藏 CANG : To hide, to conceal; to put away; to be in retirement. To hoard; to store up.

YU 彘 Elegant, accomplished. Rich in colour, brilliant.

27 SHUFU 俞 府

SHU/YU 俞

YU : To answer in the affirmative; to reply as a maid servant. Quiet.

FU 府 A store-house; a treasury; a palace. A political division ("Prefecture", as established under the Tang dynasty); the officer governing it.

13QIHU 氣 戶 CH'I HU

Qi 氣 Breath, vapour, air, steam. Weather; atmosphere. Manner, temper; feelings; influence, force, life-giving principle, vital fluid, ether.

Hu 戶 A door; an individual; a family.

14 KUFANG 庫 房 K'U FANG

Ku 庫 A treasury. A storehouse, a granary; an armoury.

Fang 房 A room, a building. Branches of a family. A wife or concubine. Office or bureau in a Yamen. The seed-case of a flower

15 WUYI 屋 翳 WU I

Wu 屋 A house; a room. To stop.

YI 翳 A feather screen or fan; to shade, to screen.

16 YINGCHUANG 膺 窗 YING CH'UANG

Ying 膺 The breast. Ornaments on the breast of a horse. To bear, to sustain. To receive. To oppose.

Chuang 窗 A window, a shutter; an opening.

17 RUZHONG 乳 中 JU CHUNG

Ru 乳 Milk; the breasts; a teat, anipple. To suckle.
